One of our primary focus support groups is our General Encouragement Support Group every Thursday evening at 6:30pm, open to anyone. We invite individuals, family & friends, facing the struggle of substance misuse, addiction, or any life difficulty.

These groups are confidential, non-judgmental, open and a safe place to share. This is a place to process the difficulties of facing these realities. We offer prayer, encouragement, wisdom through scripture, educational topics, and allow the opportunity to share and derive feedback.
